### Fall 2022 BAP Service Activities Guide

#### Adopt-A-Roads

- BAP is in charge of taking care of a section of road on campus, during this event you will help pick up trash/maintain the road. Masks are encouraged.
- You must sign up on KnightsConnect for the date you want to attend beforehand.

#### Books for literacy(Bookz for Kidz!)

- Bookz for Kidz! is dedicated to donating books to the children who do not have the means of acquiring them. This focuses on literacy for children as well.
- Each book can be donated for .5 service points with a maximum of 3 points.
- To receive these points, the participants must donate books with a focus on literacy (i.e. chapter books)
- VP of Chapter Activities (Nathan) will announce dates for book collections,

#### Individual Service Activities

- 5 hours of individual service hours (not hosted by BAP) at a non-profit organization.
- You can individually volunteer with organizations such as Second Harvest, Clean the World, Project Downtown Orlando, etc. You are encouraged to volunteer for causes you are passionate about.
- One hour = One Service Point, capped at 5 points.

- Proof of completion is required along with a picture of yourself while volunteering.

#### Special Hearts Farm

- The Special Hearts Farm, “Special Animals for Special Hearts,” is a non-profit organization that serves individuals with disabilities and unique abilities by providing adult day training, supported employment, and possible entrepreneur business opportunities related to farming and gardening experiences.
- BAP volunteers will be assigned to help around the farm, masks are required.
- Special Hearts Farm is located at *1100 East Maple Street, Winter Garden FL 34787*, bonus points will be given for carpooling.

#### Second Harvest Food Bank (w/ RSM, EY,PwC)

- Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida is a nonprofit organization that distributes donated food to more than [550 feeding partners](#) in Central Florida. Last year, with the help of numerous donors, volunteers and a caring, committed community, the food bank distributed enough food for 73 million meals to partner programs such as food pantries, soup kitchens, women’s shelters, senior centers, day care centers and Kids Cafes.



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- BAP volunteers will have the opportunity to volunteer alongside professionals from RSM, PwC, or EY. Sign-up sheets will be sent before each event.
- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes are required & appropriate clothing (no spaghetti straps, crop tops, short shorts, see-through clothing) as per Second Harvest guidelines.
- Masks are required as per Second Harvest guidelines..
- Second Harvest Food bank is located at *411 Mercy Drive, Orlando, FL 32805*, bonus points will be given for carpooling.
